

Grantee Conference Summary

The Grantee Conference is an opportunity for your organization and the Foundation to fully address any questions about the grant, its administration, and particularly your post-grant reporting requirements. The conference also gives us an opportunity to introduce you to our Foundation staff. It is important that the CEO of your nonprofit organization, a member from your Board and anyone responsible for the administration of the grant be present to gain the maximum benefit from this meeting.

The purposes of the meeting are:

- 1. Discuss the proposal process and the offered grant letter. Provide a forum to answer any questions about the offered grant before accepting the Foundation's terms and conditions.
- 2. Determine projected timeline and completion dates. Clarify any terms and conditions that may be part of the offered grant, especially matching requirements or other threshold requirements.
- 3. Introduce Foundation staff to the staff of the nonprofit organization.
- 4. Discuss post-grant reporting requirements which enable Foundation staff to better review success of the grant.
- 5. Grantee submits to the Foundation the Grant Acceptance Letter and signed Exhibit A General Terms and Conditions, if not submitted electronically.
